Hi Heather,

As per Commissioner Caldwell's Minute #2 (attached as a reference), I would like to provide my availability (from the Applicant's side) to escort Commissioner Caldwell on his site visit (as per paragraphs 10 & 11).

Availability (in no particular order):

1. Wednesday (2nd) – 9 am to 12 pm
2. Thursday (3rd) – 8:30 am to 4 pm
